CLERK: Mr. President the motion is starting the week of March 5th, we meet in formal session only Monday through Thursday, signed Senator Carpenter.

SPEAKER: Alright, all those in favor of the motion vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Now have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 18 nays, 13 not voting Mr. President.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I'd ask that this be referred to the rules committee, it's a change in the rules and it should go through the proper procedure.

SPEAKER: I don't know whether it is a change in the rules or not, but I'm referring it to the rules committee. Any more business on the Clerk's desk?

CLERK: Mr. President your enrolling clerk reports that seated on this day at 10:15 present to the Governor for his approval LB 57, 58, 59, and 291, signed Barbara Jackson, enrolling clerk. Mr. President Notice of Committee Hearings (read). Mr. President the Standing Committee Report (read). Mr. President there is pending a motion by Senator Rasmussen to withdraw LB 473, the motion was first made last Friday I believe and laid over. It's found on page 466 of the journal.

CLERK: 466, section 473.
