CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, 15 not voting, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SPEAKER: The motion passes. LB 249 will be returned to Select File.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp ask to be excused for the balance of the day.

SPEAKER: Are there any objections? If not, Senator DeCamp is excused. Mr. Clerk, are there any Resolutions.

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Mr. Clerk, is there any bills to introduce?

CLERK: I don't have any, Mr. President, but I think there should be. Here comes some. Mr. President, I move for the introduction of the attached bill. Read title. LB 493.

SPEAKER: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I move for the introduction... Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I move for the introduction of this bill. You have a statement of intent on your desk and if you will remember about a week or so ago Senator Keyes in commenting on the introduction of bills mentioned that when he was sick that the 20th day passed by and he was not privileged to introduce a certain bill. He came to the Public Works Committee and asked that the Public Works Committee introduce this bill. We went to the Executive Committee and they did give the Public Works Committee permission to introduce this bill. So, I think it would be better if Senator Keyes would explain the bill that he wants introduced through the Public Works Committee.

SPEAKER: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, Mr. President, in counties that are not growing and do not have industrial complexes coming out, this bill does not, perhaps, pertain to them too much. All this will do, and I took this statute from the state. All this will do will give to the county the same authority as the state has on state roads. To do anything that they see fit within the statute for controlling safe..for safety, egress and ingress on county roads where a business is going in. This simply gives the county the prerogative that they wish to work with the industrial site coming in on a frontage road, controlled access, etc. It is permissive. It is not mandatory but they would like to have and I would like to have them have this authority.

SPEAKER: Is there further discussion? If not, the motion is to introduce a new bill. Senator Kremer, did you care to close? It will take 30 votes. Everybody in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

SPEAKER: Senator Keyes. Have you all voted? It requires 30 votes.

SENATOR KEYES: A Call of the House.
