

SENATOR MOYLAN: Mr. President and Members of the Legislature. I explained the amendment this morning and I move that it be adopted.

SPEAKER: Further discussion? If not, the Chair wishes to say that it takes 25 votes. Those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The amendments are adopted. Senator Moylan, do you wish to move it to E&R for Engrossment?

SENATOR MOYLAN: Mr. Chairman and Members, I move that L.B. 32 be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

SPEAKER: It has been moved and seconded that L.B. 32 be advanced to E&R for Engrossment. It takes 25 votes. Those in favor, oh, just voice votes. Those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is carried.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, L.B. 249 was earlier returned from final reading to select file to consider the Murphy amendment.

SPEAKER: Senator Murphy, do you wish to speak in favor of your motion?

SENATOR MURPHY: I don't believe so, I think the body is fully aware of what we're talking about. There is no point in taking any more time with it, I don't believe.

SPEAKER: Question has been called for. Those in--let's see--there is a motion to adopt and it takes 25 votes. Those in favor signify by voting aye. Those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

SPEAKER: Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, no nays, remainder not voting.

SPEAKER: The motion carries. Senator Murphy, do you care to move that the bill be advanced to E&R for Engrossment? It has been moved and seconded that L.B. 249 be advanced to E&R for Engrossment. Those in favor say aye. Opposed vote no. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there was pending or there was bracketed for today, L.B. 197 on select file. The E&R amendments have been adopted. Senator Barnett offered some unanimous consent amendments to which Senator Kremer objected. The bill was bracketed until today. The Barnett amendments were printed in the Journal.

SPEAKER: Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I, Mr. President, I passed around to everybody this morning, if you will notice, a slip that says "amendments to L.B. 197" and explanation on a sheet, second sheet that accompanied it. There is two different parts to this. We had made the arrangements between Senator Carpenter, Senator Kremer and myself that we would get together and bring to the floor today the amendments that we wanted adopted on this 197. Now, there has been a question brought to me by Senator Kelly and I would like to add to the amendment that I gave to the body this morning, at the end of the 79-2201 section, at the end of the word where it says to member school districts. I would like to add the language (read) and I think that Senator Kelly requested this, which I agreed, I thought it was in the bill, I thought it was in the amendment and I don't
