

Senator Syas as being the same bill that was amended on here yesterday. Did 251 have a limitation?

SENATOR WALDRON: No.

SENATOR BARNETT: Thank you. As 197 does.

SENATOR WALDRON: Yes. There is a slight difference. Yes.

SENATOR BARNETT: Thank you very much.

SPEAKER: Senator Dickinson, do you have a question of Senator Waldron.

SENATOR DICKINSON: I will have to phrase my debate in the form of a question, if Senator Waldron will yield. Senator Waldron, in your opinion, is this bill substantially different enough from its original form to warrant going back to public hearing and starting all over?

SENATOR WALDRON: No, I don't think so.

SPEAKER: Those in favor of returning 197 from Enrollment and Engrossment to Select File, vote aye. Those opposed, vote nay. Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: Mr. President, on the motion to return, 27 ayes, 4 nays, 18 not voting.

SPEAKER: The motion is carried. Now it is OK to consider it on Select File to be adopted. However, the chair wishes to recognize Senator Marvel first.

SENATOR MARVEL: We are going to pass out a report, about 11 pages. So, if you wonder who it's from, it's from the Appropriations Committee. It gives you the latest figures on bills that have expenditures and it gives you the agency estimate and the estimate of the fiscal analyst staff. These are without any amendments, so it's kind of a work sheet that you can use if you so desire and the RDM comes from me as per the instructions of the Committee. Thank you. The total at the moment which includes a couple of state aid to education bills, the total at the moment is \$131,000,000.

SPEAKER: The chair would recognize Senator Waldron to move to adopt this specific amendment on LB 197.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I move the amendment be adopted to LB 197.

SPEAKER: It has been moved and seconded that the specific amendment which the clerk has read twice be adopted. Those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, Mr. President, 0 nays, 19 not voting.

SPEAKER: The amendment is adopted. Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I move the bill, LB 197, be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: Everybody in favor say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced with the amendment. The clerk will read.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move for the introduction of the attached bill, signed Senator Schmit. Read.

SPEAKER: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move the introduction of the bill. This bill was requested by the Department of Agriculture. It's a bill which is
