

was thoroughly discussed here on the floor about a month ago. It has went through the Ag Committee, was, received about a two hour hearing there and then in the process we have streamed the resolution down considerably as you can see. I would ask for this.

SPEAKER: Any discussion?

CLERK: This resolution appears on page 211 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER: The motion is to adopt Resolution No. 11. Senator Rasmussen, do you care to close?

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: No, no closing.

SPEAKER: The Chair will rule that it will take 25 votes. Those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, remainder not voting.

SPEAKER: Resolution 11 is adopted. We shall now go to the first bill on general file.

CLERK: Mr. President, L.B. 184, Senator Chambers has a request to bracket L.B. 184.

SPEAKER: Senator Chambers asked for united, unanimous consent to bracket L.B. 184. Are there any objections? If not, it will be bracketed--oh, Senator DeCamp, did you wish to speak on this unanimous--you object? Mr. Clerk, has this been bracketed, asked to be bracketed once before by Senator Chambers?

CLERK: No. No, the bill is pending on general file, Mr. President. There is a motion pending on the bill which was simply left pending on February 20.

SPEAKER: The bill is bracketed. Next we will take up L.B. 255. Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 255. Mr. President, this bill was originally considered on February 16th, and again, yeah on the 16th the committee amendments were considered and the bill was laid over. It's a bill introduced by the Interim Study Committee on Agriculture signed by Senator Schmit, Kime, DeCamp, Keyes, Epke and Kremer. (read). There are committee amendments, Mr. President, by Senator Anderson, I guess, vice-chairman of the Constitutional Revision Commission.

SPEAKER: Senator Anderson, are you ready with your committee amendments?

SENATOR ANDERSON: Mr. President and Members of the Legislature, I move the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER: Will you explain the amendment?

SENATOR ANDERSON: The committee amendments are all language clarification amendments that have been suggested by the Game and Parks Commission in order to facilitate the implementation of this particular act. There is one amendment which was initiated in committee and this particular amendment specifies that these park user fee permit monies that are collected must be used by the Game and Parks Commission for the operation and maintenance of these same parks that are designated as user fee parks. The money collected must go back into the parks for which it is collected.
