SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. Brings up the general file consideration of LB 296.

CLERK: Title Read LB 296.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: We move approval of the committee amendments. These committee amendments were put in there merely to identify the voting of the stock and the share holders, and that, it actually was a typographical error on the part of the drawing of the bill, so I move it's adoption.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of the amendment, the question is shall the amendment be adopted, all those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted. Senator Stromer what is your pleasure?

SENATOR STROMER: Mr. President I move that we advance LB 296 as amended to E&R initial.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the bill? The question is shall LB 296 as amended be advanced from general file to E&R initial, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Once again have you all voted. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes Mr. President on motion to advance.

SPEAKER: Very good, the bill is advanced. Senator Proud before I recognize you, they, would like to take this time to recognize that we have seated in the south balcony eight secondary special education students from the Ashland, Greenwood area, and Ashland, Greenwood School I presume, they are of course from Senator Warner's district and their instructor is Ken Mahlin, we are delighted to have them today as visitors to the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature. The Chair recognizes Speaker Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: Mr. President are we finished now with the non-controversial lists?

SPEAKER: That's the Chair's understanding.

SENATOR PROUD: Then I'm going to, Senator Murphy spoke to me, he has LB 390 that he believes is non-controversial. I will ask that we take that up now, I'm further going to suggest and ask for unanimous consent that we after taking up 390, that we proceed at the top of the list in general file, taking up all non-controversial bills sponsored by a Senator who is present. Now you may ask how do you know it's non-controversial, I think we should rely on the Senator's judgement, if there was opposition at the hearing I would call that a controversial bill, and all this would be subject to any objection from the body at which time we would pass over the bill. I ask unanimous consent for that.

SPEAKER: Are there objections to Senator Proud's motion. Any objections?

SENATOR PROUD: I might remark this is simply expedite the business this morning with not as many Senators as we usually have here.

SPEAKER: Thank you. Any objections? Hearing none so ordered. That's the way we will handle it then. At this time then we'll move to the general file consideration of LB 390, Senator Murphy's bill. The Clerk will read the title of LB 390.
