SENATOR BARNETT: Now, Senator Whitney, we've got that. Now, would you look at your draft and look at LB 17. Could you go across. We can understand the agency expenditures of \$10,000 cash fund and \$279 in General totals, \$279. Now, what's the revenue in parenthesis mean, \$269. Is that what needs to be raised by revenue. And then take the second part of it, the analyst expenditures, the figure \$354.

SENATOR WHITNEY: The \$269,000, is that what you are referring to.

SENATOR BARNETT: Right.

SENATOR WHITNEY: That means we are losing revenue from cash funds.

SENATOR BARNETT: OK. Now you go on over to the other part. The analyst, \$85; total \$251; general \$336; cash; and then a total of \$354. This is...I asked Senator Nore a minute ago and he couldn't explain it either and he's on the Budget Committee.

SPEAKER: Senator Nore, says you discussed that yesterday.

SENATOR WHITNEY: There is a change in the manner in which the agency expends fund here.

SENATOR BARNETT: Well, listen, I tell you. I won't take any more of...if anybody else has any more interest, let him come over and I will try to get together with Eldon... Thank you.

SPEAKER: The chair rec...we have LB 339.

CLERK: Read title. LB 339. There are committee amendments by Senator Carstens' Banking, Commerce, and Insurance Committee.

SPEAKER: The chair recognizes Senator Fred Carstens.

SENATOR FRED CARSTENS: Mr. President, the committee amendments at the present time are...that are on this bill are merely corrective and do not change the bill in any fashion or form, and were placed in there in order to make the bill, to clarify the bill. I move the committee amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the committee amendments. All those in favor of adopting the committee amendments, please say aye. Those opposed say no. The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Luedtke, what is your pleasure?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that LB 339 be advanced to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER: Excuse me, Senator Carpenter, did you have an amendment or ...

SENATOR CARPENTER: Why, I have an amendment. Yes.

SPEAKER: Very good.

SENATOR CARPENTER: It is a minor amendment. It only changes the word "may" to "shall".

SPEAKER: Well, very good. Senator Luedtke, go ahead and explain the bill. Go ahead, sir.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: I don't oppose that. I don't know whether some of the boards will, but I don't. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that LB 339 be advanced because this affects all of the political subdivisions Board of Director members individually. We have a Tort Claims Act on the books affecting political subdivisions, that's the
