SENATOR DUIS: Well I wouldn't see any reason why they couldn't.

SENATOR NORE: This isn't a professional bill then?

SENATOR DUIS: Pardon.

SENATOR NORE: This isn't a professional interest bill?

SENATOR DUIS: Well the court could appoint you as a referee too, sir.

SPEAKER: The batting order here is Senators Fellman, Carstens, and Kelly and I'm going to call on them in that order. Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Senator Duis would you yield to a question?

SENATOR DUIS: You know I certainly appreciate these questions, you know I haven't explained this bill in one iota to begin with yet, even section by section, or one word, we started out with an amendment here and all I've had is questions about the bill, dipping in here and dipping out there, and so on and so forth and I really appreciate it, I'll go ahead and keep right on answering questions, but lets don't make me go through it the second time, if and when we get to the thought of this bill because I assure you this bill was not gotten up to take somebody out of business or do this and that, this bill was a recodification with certain qualification changes and such as that and Senator Carpenter the other day, we desired to have an amendment on this bill, which we got together on and agreed on and I think it took care of a lot of these objections, and I don't think very many people have really listened to the amendment, so with your kind consideration Senator Fellman, I would suggest that we hold the bill over a week, let's hold it over a week, because Allen Bean back here has got after me yesterday all of a sudden a bunch of attorneys decided they wanted to sell some more real estate apparently, I don't know why or what the deal was, but we went clear through the committee hearing, we had a conference with them, we did everything imaginable and all of a sudden they found something, this is fine with me, I have no intentions of putting anything over on any body, so I'm going to ask to have LB 68, 68A and 86 bracketed for another week, just go right to it and let's get it all done and let's, visit with me just a little bit about it sometime, I'll try and help you, but I do have a complete explanation of this bill, section by section, which as of this morning I haven't been able to give and I would like to do that before too many people start picking it apart.

SPEAKER: Senator Fellman would like to make a short comment.

SENATOR FELLMAN: I'm in total agreement with the Senator, I'd just like him to know I, the question I have that hasn't been answered is not on behalf of the lawyers, but from a real estate broker that has some questions about it, but I'll be happy to ask him privately.

SENATOR DUIS: You know you go right ahead and ask me the question a number of real estate brokers have, please -

SPEAKER: Senator Duis is asking unanimous consent to hold this, or to bracket this bill from, one week from today, and I assume Senator Duis, that you would include in your motion that Senator Carpenter's amendment be printed in the journal, is that correct? Now is there anybody that has any objections to this procedure? Hearing no objections, it is so ordered. Now the next bill is 68A, I suppose that would just maintain it's order, Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: My request was for 68, 68A and 86, all to be bracketed for a week. They all pertain -
