SENATOR LUEDTKE: But they stopped it last year so maybe you can stop it again.

SPEAKER: Well Senator Chambers, what do you have to say to that?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'll be sporting let the five go together.

SPEAKER: The Clerk will record.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Thank you Senator Chambers.

CLERK: 32 ayes Mr. President on a motion to suspend the rules. Mr. President LB 500 Title Read. LB 501 Title Read. LB 502 Title Read. LB 503 Title Read. LB 504 Title Read. Mr. President notice of Committee Hearings (read).

SPEAKER: Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President and members of the body, a point of personal privilege. I have put a letter on the Speaker's desk, I'd like unanimous consent to have it printed in the journal.

CLERK: I don't have the letter. Oh.

SPEAKER: Any objections to having whatever Senator Stahmer asked to be printed in the journal? Hearing none, so ordered. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: The Education Committee has five bills that they want to have rereferred because they have a back log. I'm going to make a motion tomorrow to put these bills on general file because they are nothing except a change in the meeting dates of schools. I want to give the number so if you want to look at them between now and then, it's 412, 413, 429, 430, and 435. These are completely unimportant bills, they only have to do with the changing of dates of meetings.
