

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Mr. President and Members of the Legislature, I'd like to, if it's possible at this time, take up Legislative Resolution 13 which has to do with the, we had a hearing on, I think it was last week, and it's pretty necessary if it's possible, to take it at this time too, because there's a delegation going to Washington and they'd like to, if it's the consent of this body, to pass this resolution, to take it with them. The hearing has been held and if there is no objection, sir, I'd like to take it up.

SPEAKER: We'll test the water. Any objections to taking up Legislative Resolution No. 13 at this time? Any objections? Just a second, Senator Hasebroock, do you know what page it's on, sir?

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: It's in the Journal on page 680.

SPEAKER: Page 680 in the Journal, thank you.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Correction, that's the page that the amendments are found on, the committee amendments.

SPEAKER: Stand by.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: The original resolution is found on page 341.

SPEAKER: Got it, 341. Are there any objections to taking up the resolution? Hearing none, it is so ordered, we're going to make that the next order of business then, Legislative Resolution No. 13. Go ahead, Senator Hasebroock.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: There is a committee amendment by the committee, I think Senator Kremer has those.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, this amendment was brought to the committee and it adds one whereas, that's the way I defined it and also one new section at the bottom of the resolution. The whereas actually states the fact that Nebraska is not evidently getting back its share of the funds which we contribute only to the extent of about 80% and it calls attention to that, and then you'll notice on the amendment if you have it before you, suggests this, that the 1973 session of the Legislature, State of Nebraska, go on record as urging the Federal Administration and the Congress to correct the manner of apportioning money among the states from the Federal Highway trust fund so that Nebraska will be treated more fairly and just in simple language, it suggests that we are only getting back about 80% and we deserve more than that and the committee saw fit to adopt the amendment with the resolution so I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the motion regarding the amendment? Senator Whitney. Speaking on just the amendment.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, I'm in favor of the amendment. I believe that those people that pay the taxes ought to get them back to the State of Nebraska, unfortunately, the present State Aid to Education Bill does not do that and I hope this Legislature will take cognizant, cognizance of that fact and if we want to get back what we give to Washington, then some school districts want to get back what they pay in to the State.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the committee amendments. Senator Syas, do you wish to be heard on the committee amendments? Are you ready to vote on that issue? All those in favor of adopting the committee amendments then to Legislative Resolution No. 13 say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered. The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Hasebroock, back to you.
