Once again the Chair is asking you to please take your seats, we are trying to proceed on final reading. Okay, the Clerk will proceed with the final reading of LB 46. Attention please.

CLERK: Title read LB 46.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: A call of the house.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter is asking for a call of the house. The Clerk will clear the board. At the next bill please indicate your support of the motion for a call of the house. You are voting on a call of the house. This is a motion for a vote of a call of the house. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 14 nays Mr. President on a call of the house.

SPEAKER: We are under call of the house. Clear the board, at the next bill please indicate your presence.

CLERK: Senator Duis voting no on the original motion.

SPEAKER: Senator Duis voting no. Have you all indicated your presence? Do we know who is excused?
