SPEAKER: Okay, we are now under a call of the house, the Senators will please get in their seats and stay there and we have under vote of course the return of LB 194 for specific amendments. At the next bell please indicate your presence, you are under a call of the house, Senator Fred Carstens voting aye on the original question.

CLERK: Senator Fred Carstens voting aye on the original motion.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter voting aye on the original motion.

CLERK: Senator Carpenter voting aye on the original motion.

SPEAKER: Senator Chambers voting aye on the original motion.

CLERK: Senator Chambers voting aye on the original motion.

SPEAKER: Senator Stahmer voting.

CLERK: Senator Stahmer changing from nay to aye.

SPEAKER: Senator Stahmer voting aye. Senator Warner we are under a call of the house.

CLERK: Senator Waldron voting aye on the original motion.

SPEAKER: Waldron voting aye. We are under call of the house. Apparently there are 13 not registering their presence. Right. Will the Clerk please advise the Sgt At Arms that Senator Proud is here. The motion under vote of course is the return from E&R for engrossing to select file LB 194 for the Barnett specific amendment. While we are waiting and we have a lull here, the Chair would like to introduce forty five seniors from East High School in Lincoln, just by chance from Senator Luedtke's district, they are seated in the south balcony and instructor is Mrs. Ann Barry, we are delighted to have you here today as observers of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature. Well we used to do that, but when you have several groups in here during the day it does disrupt the activities and so we just announce your appearance here will be recorded in the journal, so everybody will know you were here. Sure beats going to school doesn't it? We are still under call of the house, Senator Carpenter for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the call be raised.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter has now moved that the call be raised. The Clerk will clear the board. All those in favor of raising the call please vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The motion is to raise the call of the house. Have you all voted, the Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 3 nays, to raise the call.

SPEAKER: The call is raised. Read the talley of the original vote, on the issue. That was a record vote.

CLERK: Vote read. 24 ayes, 15 nays, remainder not voting.

SPEAKER: The motion to return to select file fails. Do we have any other motions?

CLERK: Mr. President I ask unanimous consent to withdraw LB 514, signed Senator Stull.

SPEAKER: The motion will be laid over.

CLERK: Mr. President there is pending a motion by Senator Fellman to withdraw LB 456. It was laid over from yesterday.
