SENATOR WHITNEY: I so move that all three of these men, Claude Jelen, Jack Lederman and John Shoemaker, be approved by this legislature.

SPEAKER: You have heard Senator Whitney's motion to approve the appointment of these three individuals, all those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. Voting on the three appointments as outlined by Senator Whitney, one vote is sufficient to confirm the appointment of all three. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.
