PRESIDENT: Have you all indicated your presence? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Forum present Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Are there corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Excellent. Do we have notices of committee hearings or reports?

CLERK: Mr. President I have two communications, one from the Executive Office addressed to the Honorable Speaker Proud (read communication). Another letter from the Executive Office dated March 12th, addressed to the President, Speaker and members of the Legislature (read communication). Read communication from J. Cavanaugh. Enrolling Clerk reports that she on this date at 8:25 presented the Governor for his approval LB13, 13A, 34, 224, 339, 351, and 390, signed, Barbara Jackson.

PRESIDENT: While the legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I am signing LB46, 138, LB210, LB241 subsequent there to and in conclusion LB243.

CLERK: Notice of committee hearing, the revenue committee will hold hearings on LB530 and LB534 on Wednesday, March 21, 1973, signed Senator Burbach, Chairman. Mr. President your committee on Labor to whom was referred LB260 instructs me to report the same to the legislature the recommendation be indefinitely postponed. LB270 indefinitely postponed and 292 indefinitely postponed. Signed Senator Maresh, Chairman. That is all Mr. President. First bill on Final Reading this morning will be LB173. We are trying to clear the floor if we can get the Senators in their seats we will begin Final Reading. Once again if we can ask the Senators to take their seats we can begin final reading. Attention Final Reading of LB173, the assistant clerk will read the bill.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote Aye, those opposed vote No. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Voting Aye, Senators, Anderson, Burbach, Carpenter, Carsten, Carstens, Cavanaugh, Clark, DeCamp, Duis, Epke, Fellman, Fowler, Johnson, Kelly, Kennedy, Keyes, Kremer, F. Lewis, Luedtke, Mahoney, Maresh, Marsh, Marvel, Moylan, Murphy, Nore, Proud, Rasmussen, Savage, Schmit, Simpson, Skarda, Snyder, Stahmer, Stromer, Syas, Waldron, Warner, Whitney and Wiltse. Voting Nay, None, not voting Senators Chambers, Dickinson, Goodrich, Hasebroock, correction Hasebroock voting Aye, Kime, R. Lewis, Richendifer, and Stull. 42 Ayes, 0 Nays, and 7 not voting.
