

CLERK: 3 Ayes, 30 Nays Mr. President, and 16 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The motion is lost. Is there any other amendment on the desk, to the committee amendments to LB452?

CLERK: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Before we take up the next amendment here, Senator and Mrs. Thome Johnson have here this morning a very special guest that I would like to introduce and I would like to have the Legislature recognize and that is Mrs. Bernard Ausen from Versailles, France and Mrs. Bill Johnson and Mrs. Phil James from Fremont. I believe that they are seated under the south balcony and I would really like to have them step forward so that we could recognize the visitor from Versailles, France. Would you please step out there so that we can see you. Thank you. Additionally it is the Chairs pleasure to introduce to the body Miss Liliansa Martins from the city of Marilia, Sao Paulo State of Brazil and she is accompanied by Jim and Shawn Belschner from Amherst, and Miss Martins is an exchange student there at Amherst High School would you stand up so that we can recognize them also. We are glad to have you here as visitors. Now we have another amendment.

CLERK: Read

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature section 48 as it now reads director appointing a building manager who shall control be the custodian of the capital the custodian of the governors mansion and other janitorial and housekeeping functions. It seems to me that this is outside the intent of the bill itself and there is no reason to remove this inside housekeeping, and literally housekeeping from the Governor, he ought to regardless of who he is to be able to appoint whoever he wants to be the head janitor or the head custodian at the mansion and have the same control here in the building. Therefore I ask unanimous consent for this amendment which substitutes the governor and allows him to make these appointments.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Fellman is asking unanimous consent for the motion. Senator Mahoney do you object?

SENATOR MAHONEY: No, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to the amendment? Bill is on General File, and I feel that the bill should be or rather that the amendment should be voted upon. Any further discussion of the motion? Do you all understand the motion? Do you want the motion read again. Alright we have a request to read the motion again.

CLERK: Read

PRESIDENT: Question is shall the amendment be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting on the Fellman amendment to the committee amendment to LB452. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 Ayes, 9 Nays and 14 Not Voting.

PRESIDENT: Amendment is adopted. Back to Senator Marvel.
