CLERK: Reading bill.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the legislature, -

SPEAKER: Let's restore a little order in the place please.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I ask for suspension of the rules, I move for the suspension of the rules to introduce this bill, at this time. The reason for this bill is because the Federal Government is going to withdraw their Federal Inspectors from the livestock market at Omaha, Nebraska, and if we are going to have livestock inspection there, then the state will have to provide for these inspectors. At the present time we have a system of livestock inspection at the auction market, which is handled by cooperation through the various auction markets and the Veterinarians, and the Department of Agriculture has agreed to work with the livestock market at Omaha, to work out a plan whereby we can provide state inspection and carry on the livestock trading business at Omaha. You know we must have, we must have inspection, otherwise you cannot have a trading and so therefore, I would hope the legislature would allow us to introduce this bill. It should not be controversial but it is a necessary piece of legislation.

SPEAKER: Do you need more discussion on the motion? Is there any need for further discussion of the motion, Senator Cavanaugh did you wish to be recognized? Senator Warner did you wish to be recognized? The question is shall the rules be suspended and the bill introduced, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. You are voting to suspend the rules and introduce the bill as outlined by, you are voting on a suspension of the rules in order to introduce the bill. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, no nays Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Very good, the Clerk want to read the title.

CLERK: Read.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: This is a bill to help out the Department of Public Institutions by simply designating certain areas of a regional center, that can be used for either skilled or intermediate care. This does not require additional renovation, this does not require anything except just official designation. Without this there certain title 19 funds they cannot get. That's the only purpose of this bill.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion? The question is shall the rules - Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: What I'd like to ask the introducers of these three bills, whatever the number is, in their judgement are they noncontroversial, the things we have to do, is that correct?

SPEAKER: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir, and I think they can be put directly on general file, without a public hearing.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I will contact, the purpose of the question, I will contact the other members of the Executive Council to get their permission to put it on general file, without a hearing,
