SENATOR CARSTENS: Mr. President and members of the body, this particular section was brought to my attention by a county judge out at McCook. Heretofore it had been brought to his attention. Apparently, this judge had been doing some of the exact provisions that this bill has, but it was brought to his attention that they might not be covered in case of injury, and he recommended that we amend this section so that any sentence that is pronounced in this area, that any offender would be covered from, under all courts rather than just those mentioned, and this is the amendment, just merely provides for coverage under all the courts.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the amendment, do you all understand the amendment? All those in favor of the Carstens amendment will say aye, those opposed say no, so ordered, the amendment is adopted then.

SENATOR CARSTENS: Now Mr. President I move to advance LB 25 to E&R for engrossing. Mr. President and members of the body, LB 25 as I explained at the hearing was brought, the suggestion for this bill was brought to me by a little girl in the Government Class, freshman Government Class in the high school.
