

CLERK: Read

PRESIDENT: While all provisions of law relative to procedure haveing been complied with, the question is, "Shall the bill pass?" All those in favor vote Aye, those opposed vote No. The Chair would call to your attention that in order for this bill to be placed on the primary ballot, it does require the support with 40 votes. If it doesn't receive 40 votes then it will be revoted upon for the general election with an automatic amendment and 30 votes are then required for passage. The Chair would ask if you have all voted? Alright, Senator Syas asking for a call of the house. Clerk will clear the board. Senator Syas.....

CLERK: Senator Nore voting Aye.

PRESIDENT: Alright the next bell please indicate whether you support a call of the house or not. This is to indicate your support of a call of the house. Have you all voted? We are under a call of the house. Could you with this same bell also indicate your presence here. If you support a call of the house also, would you indicate.... Senator Syas, we are under a call of the house. Have you all indicated your presence? Clerk will clear the board.

CLERK: We've got '1.

PRESIDENT: OK, motion next is to raise the call. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting now to raise the call of the house. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 37 Ayes, Mr. President to raise the call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised.

CLERK: Read vote.

PRESIDENT: Wait a minute, stand by, Senator Chambers voting aye.

CLERK: Read, 42 ayes, 5 nays, and 2 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed and will be placed on the primary ballot. Well that cleans up final reading.

CLERK: President I have a motion to reconsider our action on LB231. I would respectfully suggest to the chair that it is out of time.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett, I'm advised that your motion on this particular action is out of time and that the time for reconsideration of 232 has gone by. Therefore your motion will have to be to suspend the rules in order to take up the consideration or the reconsideration here of LB231.

BARNETT: OK, Mr. President, I would like to see where you get that ruling. I have already read that and it says 5 days. The action was taken last Tuesday that would make 5 days today.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett, do you have your rule book handy there. Would you turn to page 39 please. You see section 7 under rule 7.

BARNETT: I sure do.
