SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB206.

CLERK: There are no E & R amendments Mr. President, there is just Thomas Kennedy's specific amendments on it, by Senator Kennedy.

PRESIDENT: We have returned the bill to.... I am sorry Senator Cavanaugh, it was my miscue here. This is the bill which was returned this morning from Final Reading. We are ready now for Senator Kennedy's specific amendments to LB206 on Select File. Before we launch into that, Senator Kennedy may I interrupt you to introduce 23 students from 10th-12th grade, they are from Westpoint Public Schools from Westpoint, Nebraska, and of course that is Senator Hasebrook's home territory up there. Their instructor is Mrs. Letitia Munson and they are seated in the north balcony, and we are delighted to have you here today as observers to the only unicameral Legislature in the United States. Thank you, and I see that Senator Hasebrook is up there with them, so they are in good hands. Senator, you be sure to make them feel welcome, won't you. Very good. Now, back to you Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes, Mr. President and fellow members, there was a copy of the amendments on LB206 sent out and if you would care to be bored to death, I would go into detail, but all of the language that Senator Kremer and I and one of the attorneys went through is a clarification of language only to determine exact, as near as possible, in the statements on many of these sections, and after spending a week with a number of attorneys and all people involved there seems to be a complication that this should be done rather than by rules and regulations and I certainly agreed and would ask for your wisdom, and if you do have any questions, I would ask for amendments to be adopted on LB206 as stated on the paper that was handed out to you this morning. Any questions?

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the resolution? Excuse me, of the motion? Any further discussion of the motion?

SENATOR KENNEDY: I would move for the adoption of the amendments on LB206.

PRESIDENT: Question is, "Shall the amendments of LB206, as explained by Senator Kennedy be adopted?" All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Senator Kennedy asking for approval of his amendments to LB206. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, none nays, 23 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Very good. The amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Kennedy, what is your pleasure?

SENATOR KENNEDY: I move that LB206, as amended, be put back to E & R for engrossing. Thank you.
