PRESIDENT: Stand by, Senator Whitney, we're attempting to locate Senator Maresh. Senator Schmit, we're only short Senator Maresh, do you want to impose on the body--

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I withdraw my objection and hopefully, Senator Maresh will be brought into the body before the roll call is completed.

PRESIDENT: We do have a posse out after him so, stand by. All right. Let's begin the roll call vote here.

CLERK: Roll call vote read. 31 ayes, 16 nays, 2 not voting.

PRESIDENT: L.B. 13 passes notwithstanding the objection of the Governor. That brings up for consideration I believe, L.B. 13A.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that L.B. 13A be enacted into law notwithstanding the action of the Governor. Signed Senator Schmit.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and Members of the Legislature. I have no further arguments. I move the bill be enacted into law.

PRESIDENT: Is there a need for further discussion? Question is shall L.B. 13A pass notwithstanding the action of the Governor, excuse me, shall 13A pass notwithstanding the objection of the Governor? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. I would remind the body we're still under a call of the house. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Roll call vote read.

PRESIDENT: We're under a call of the house, Senator Kennedy.

CLERK: Roll call vote continued. 40, correction; 30 ayes, 16 nays, 3 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed notwithstanding the objection of the Governor. Chair recognizes Senator Stromer there.

SENATOR STROMER: Mr. President, I move we raise the call.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to raise the call. All those in favor of raising the call vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Have you all voted. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 38 ayes, to raise the call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised. Do we have another motion on the desk?

CLERK: Request read.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I have, Mr. President; Vince, have the E&R amendments been adopted or--

CLERK: Negative.

SENATOR MARVEL: Well, maybe you better adopt those first and then I'll refer to the others.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh, do you want to make the motion to adopt the E&R amendments to L.B. 452 and then we'll consider Senator Marvel's amendments to this bill.
