SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to L.B. 452.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to adopt the E&R amendments to L.B. 452. All those in favor of the motion, please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: All right, then, Mr. President, we have pending a motion by Senator Carpenter to add the severability clause. Unanimous consent.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Carpenter has asked for unanimous consent to add the severability clause to L.B. 452. Excuse me. Senator Marvel, your severability clause is in the other amendments? Okay. Thank you, we'll disregard Senator Carpenter's motion then, take it up with Senator Marvel's motion.

SENATOR MARVEL: Now, I'm operating on a unanimous consent motion to adopt the amendments and I'd like to explain them briefly. In a complicated bill such as this, throughout the bill are certain amendments having to do with internal reference. In the second place, there is incorporated in this bill as per discussion the other day a suggestion that the Legislature and the Governor be assured access to information. In the third place there is provision to provide guidelines and restrictions to the operation of purchasing accounting and data processing. In the fourth place there is the emergency clause and a severability clause so that the bill would take effect immediately upon approval by the Legislature. I ask unanimous consent that these amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the amendments? Do you need to have the amendment read? Are there objections to the amendment? Any objections to Senator Marvel's amendment? Hearing none, it is so ordered, the amendment is adopted.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move that 452 be advanced to E&R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Is there a need for further discussion now of L.B. 452? Question is shall L.B. 452 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossment? All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the bill as amended is advanced. Do we have any other motions then on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, (motion read).

PRESIDENT: All right. It'll be laid over. Read the other report.

CLERK: Report read. Committee hearings read.
