SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move that LB 380 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to advance the bill. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 77.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to 77. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move that LB 77 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move that LB 77A be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 77A. All those in favor of the motion, please say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 162.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to LB 162. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a unanimous consent amendment on LB 162 by Senator Waldron who I understand Senator Whitney will take up the amendment. Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Just a minute. Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: What it does is on the Court Reporters, it reduces the salary from \$14,500 down to \$14,000. It just reduces it by \$500. This would put it in line with the increases in salaries of state employees and the bill looked like it was in trouble when it came across General File and I said I'd like to vote in favor of this bill and if he'd take \$500 off, that would still leave a very healthy increase, and so I ask unanimous consent that this amendment be placed on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Are there any objections to the amendment to the bill on Select File? Any objections to the amendment? Senator Snyder, do you object.

SENATOR SNYDER: A question.

PRESIDENT: Yes.

SENATOR SNYDER: What is the current salary of the Court Reporters?

PRESIDENT: Twelve something.

SENATOR SNYDER: What is the current salary of the Court Reporters?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Well, it would go up \$2000. \$12,000 up to \$14,000, I believe that is it, isn't it?

CLERK: \$12,500 currently.
