SENATOR WHITNEY: \$12,500. It would go up then \$1500, and that would be a greater increase then for the...then we've committed in the last two years for the state employees.

PRESIDENT: Are there any objections to the amendment? Hearing none. So ordered. The amendment is adopted. We have 162 as amended, now.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move that LB 162 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor of advancing the bill as amended, please say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move that LB 162A be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: The motion, now, is to advance LB 162A. Is there an amendment on that one, too.

SENATOR SNYDER: Won't we have to change the "A" bill on that then? It will be lower anyway. Let's go ahead, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: They will have to coincide. All right. All those in favor of the advancement of LB 162A say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move that LB 43A be advanced...

CLERK: Senator Stull has a request to bracket 43A on Select File. He has pending a proposed amendment to 43 and would like to keep them there together.

PRESIDENT: All right.

SENATOR SNYDER: I'll withdraw the motion.

PRESIDENT: Are there any objections to bracketing 43A on Select File? Hearing none. So ordered. We will bracket the bill.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 25.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to adopt the amendments to LB 25. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, then I move that LB 25 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of the motion, please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill as amended is advanced. Thank you, Senator Snyder.
