I have had no letters or any inquiry from anybody from my district and if anybody here has from their districts, if somebody don't understand the bill, I have no objection to passing them over. On the other hand, if you do not have any objection, I want to move to pass them over...to move them on.

PRESIDENT: Are there any objections to moving the bills on here. Senator Kelly, are you offering an objection. Senator Carpenter is asking, he is saying that if there is objection to any of these bills why we will pass over them, but go ahead, sir.

SENATOR KELLY: Well, I would like to ask a question to know whether I would object or not.

PRESIDENT: Go ahead.

SENATOR KELLY: In 435, they are setting up caucus to nominate school board members, but I see nothing in there about or don't understand where the caucus group would come from.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly, we will take them up one at a time. So, let's move on here with 412. May I do that and you voice your inquiry when we come to 435?

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that 412 be advanced to E & R for Initial.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of LB 412. The question is shall LB 412 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. You are voting on the advancement of LB 412. Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, 22 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 413, Senator Nore does have some amendments on it.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Then, I move we pass it over.

PRESIDENT: All right. We will pass over 413 because there are amendments to it, then. Move on to 429.

CLERK: Read title. LB 429. No. amendments.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced to E & R for Initial. What this does, it changes the dates which in the law as it now stands says the first, and it puts the new matters "or before the second Monday of each month", and I presume it only changes the meeting date from what it now exists. I move the bill be advanced to E & R for Initial.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the bill? The question is shall LB 429 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor, vote aye. All those opposed, vote no.
