CLERK: Title Read LB 512. There is one amendment to add the emergency clause.

SPEAKER: Just before we take that Senator Barnett, I didn't see your light.

SENATOR BARNETT: Do you now? I'd like to be excused for the balance of the morning.

SPEAKER: Is there any objection?

SENATOR BARNETT: Thank you.

SPEAKER: Senator Barnett I don't know if the objection was in seriousness or not, does anybody seriously object? I must be honest, you're excused.

SENATOR CARPENTER: (Mike not turned on) I have no objections, are we going to get 25 votes, has everybody voted or are we just going to spin our wheels now from now on? Still have, thank you.

SPEAKER: Senator Lewis are you going to handle this bill? The amendment. 512. It's a public health -

SENATOR LEWIS: Yes. Mr. Speaker, Mr. President, Mr. Senator Chambers, congratulations, I like to see you up there.

SPEAKER: Thank you.

SENATOR LEWIS: This is a bill that was brought to the committee by Senator Fowler and he had a specific instance in which a gentlemen licensed in another state and fully qualified to practice in this state but was limited because of the age limitation in our statutes, since that this state has now made the age of majority 19 years, this bill proposes to lower this limitation to 19 years and bring us in compliance with the other states. I move that 512 be advanced to E&R. Yes, I'm sorry, there is a committee amendment to adopt, to add the emergency clause, I would move adoption of this amendment.

SPEAKER: All those in favor of adopting these amendments say aye, all those opposed, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR LEWIS: Now I renew my motion to advance it to E&R.

SPEAKER: Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Well Senator Lewis, I didn't have time to study this bill, but would you care to explain to the body what is meant by massage, I'm not sure, what is meant by that.

SENATOR LEWIS: Come closer I'll explain it to you.

SPEAKER: All those in favor of advancing 512 vote aye, those opposed vote no. Aye. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced, that brings us to LB 488.

CLERK: Title Read LB 488. There is a committee amendment on page 2, line 14, after the coma, insert or for transporting industrial equipment (read).

SPEAKER: Senator Kremer is not here, who will handle this? The amendment.
