PRESIDENT: Thank you, sir. Senator Goodrich. I am going refrain from commenting.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Someday we are going to get somebody up there that knows how to work the buttons. I really have nothing to say. As long as Senator Barnett is out of order, we are OK.

PRESIDENT: All right. Is there any further discussion of Senator Proud's motion? I'm sorry but that struck me as extremely humorous. Any further discussion of Senator Proud's motion? The question before us is shall Resolution #23 be referred to a committee. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. This motion takes 25 votes. The question before you is shall Resolution #23 be referred to a committee for disposition. That takes 25 votes. What is your pleasure? Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 2 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion prevails and Resolution 23 is referred to a committee, will be referred to a committee. Thank you. Do we have any other motions on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Constitutional Revision and Recreation--read.
