PRESIDENT: Senator Mahoney. All right. Senator Marvel then back to you for closing. Senator Marvel is now closing on his motion, shall L.B. 323 be placed on general file notwithstanding the action of the committee.

SENATOR MARVEL: I appreciate the comprehensive discussion. I have only two brief points that have already been made, I'd like to summarize and the breadth and length of the discussion indicates the importance of this issue, therefore, the bill should be put on general file. Once again, representation: The students at the University of Nebraska had to use their own money, hire their own consultants to even study the library situation which is one of the keys to the entire matter of whether we have an adequate university or not so when we talk about whether we need additional representation, this is a very important point. The second point has to do with presentation. In the hearing, in the committee, plus discussions that we've had in our committee plus personal discussions I've had with all kinds of students impresses me with the interest they have in education and the fact that they are sincere in their attempt to make changes where changes need to be made so I think they can make a very important contribution. Therefore, I hope that you will vote to put Legislative Bill 323 on general file.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall L.B. 323 be placed on general file notwithstanding the action of the committee? All those in favor will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no. The issue does require 25 votes. Have you all voted? Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 10 nays, 11 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is placed on general file notwithstanding the action of the committee. Do we have any other motions on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a motion by Senator Stahmer to place LB 48 on general file notwithstanding the action of the committee.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. Speaker, I'd like to yield to Senator Proud for one minute, I think a personal privilege perhaps.

PRESIDENT: Very good. Senator Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: It's an announcement that--I put the letter on your desk yesterday and I made this announcement previously that the Federal Regional team will be in here to explain revenue sharing at, just before 11:00 and so I would like to ask unanimous consent that we promptly adjourn--recess at 10:55 regardless of the state of discussion and I, I don't like to break in this way but, and our time is limited but, so is this Federal team.
