SENATOR STULL: I move the amendments to LB 164 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to LB 164. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion now to move...to return LB 164 to General File for amendment. Signed, Senator Luedtke.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move to...

PRESIDENT: Go ahead. Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: ..return LB 164 because there is a specific amendment which actually makes one section comply with the other with regard to investigation of some of these tellers, teller units for auxiliary teller offices for banks. The banking department has it in subsection 12 of this act but it is not in subsection 13 with regard to investigating application for detached auxiliary tellers, so we ought to make it consistent. Moreover, the Attorney General, as I understand it, has some additional questions about some immediate amendments so we would prefer to have it sent back to General File with this attached amendment so we can take it up on General File and leave it open for the Attorney General's further amendments.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of Senator Luedtke's motion. Motion is to return LB 164 to General File for specific amendment. Any further discussion of the motion? The question is shall LB 164 be returned to General File for further amendment. All those in favor will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no. That motion requires 25 votes. You are voting, please, to return LB 164 to General File for a specific amendment as outlined by Senator Luedtke. Do you all understand what we are doing? Senator Luedtke is asking to return LB 164 to General File for a specific amendment. I suppose the chair should, also, remind you that I am not in a position to lobby for votes. Are you all through voting? Thank you. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, Mr. President, on a motion to return.

PRESIDENT: OK. LB 164, then, is returned to General File for specific amendment. Now, moves on to LB 309. Go ahead, Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: OK. I move that the amendments to LB 309 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 309. All those in favor of the motion say aye. All those opposed say no. So ordered. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR STULL: Now, I move that the bill be advanced to E & R for engrossing as amended.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of the motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. LB 309, then, as amended is advanced.

SENATOR STULL: I move that the amendments to LB 425 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 425. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The amendments are adopted.
