

CLERK: Roll call vote read. 35 ayes, no nays, 11 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. That moves us on to resolutions.

CLERK: Legislative Resolution No. 29. Introduced by Senator Syas of the 13th district. (read).

CLERK: Mr. President, an explanation of vote. (read)

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Are there other resolutions on the desk?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Do we have any other bills for introduction?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, if this is the proper time, I have a motion prepared to have L.B. 60 brought to general file notwithstanding the action of the committee.

PRESIDENT: Well, stand or just a minute. We're, we really need to move on past select file here first and then we have motions to reconsider and then we have motions to advance bills from committee. We'll put you on the list.

CLERK: Mr. President, we do have one additional committee report (read). That's all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Very good. We'll move to the consideration then of bills on select file. Is Senator Cavanaugh in the chamber?
