SPEAKER: Any discussion?

SENATOR PROUD: Does anybody want to explain? That's my explanation then.

SPEAKER: Do you care to close Senator Proud?

SENATOR PROUD: No.

SPEAKER: Those in favor of LB 258, vote aye, those opposed vote no. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 1 nay, 16 not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 319.

CLERK: Title Read LB 319. This bill was first considered on March 23rd and laid over, there are committee amendments on it Mr. President, by Senator Kremer's Public Works Committee.

SPEAKER: Senator Kremer, or Senator Richendifer have you explained this bill before.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Yes, but not the amendment.

SPEAKER: Well then we will go to Senator Kremer for an explanation of the amendment.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman I understand that Senator Richendifer has the proposal to amend the committee amendments, would that be proper to take his amendment to the committee amendments up first.

CLERK: One of his amendments appears to amend the committee amendment after the word fee, strike single abstracts and 45% of the fee on lots of ten or more, signed Senator Richendifer.

SPEAKER: Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. Chairman and members of the legislature, this rather backwards to do this, I have another amendment in here to make the fee for all abstracts the same amount, \$1.00, instead of the \$1.00 for the single and .75¢ for ten or more. When we get to that, I'll let Senator Duis explain why his thinking, he brought this to my attention. All the amendments to the committee amendments do is make it conform with the second amendment, that's all it takes out the ten abstract wording, and I would move for the adoption of the amendments to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER: Any discussion, does everybody understand it? Are you ready for the question? The question is to adopt Senator Richendifer's amendments to the committee amendments, all those in favor say aye, those opposed no, the amendments are adopted. Now have you got any other amendments Senator Richendifer?

CLERK: Not to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER: Do you want to move.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: I move that the committee amendments as amended be adopted, Mr. Chairman.
