SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I think that the 235 bill requires an A bill. I don't know any reason why it hasn't been up there on the board, because according to my fiscal note, on general file bill number 235, it has a fiscal note there which has an impact from a general fund of three million three hundred thousand dollars, and an A bill is required for any bill that has over a fifty thousand dollar price tag, so I think all we've got to do is just bracket that bill 235 on final reading until the A bill is drawn on it that is necessary and catches up there with it, and that is the reason for my motion sir, I could withdraw the motion if it is necessary, but I would like to ask Senator Marvel a question if I might?

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel in the Chamber?

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel or Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Senator Marvel, LB 235 according to the fiscal note on a general file bill would require a general fund expenditure of three million three hundred thousand dollars. Do you or do you not believe that 235 should have an A bill attached to it like every other expenditure of over fifty thousand dollars?

SENATOR MARVEL: Yeah, I think it ought to and I understand that the sponsor of the bill is going to introduce the A bill.

SENATOR DUIS: Alright, now I think that will settle our question for all morning long, that if 235 requires an A bill that of necessity must stay on final reading until that bill catches up with it.

PRESIDENT: And the Chair would so rule, and that would overrule as far as I'm concerned Senator Carpenter's motion which amends Senator Snyder's motion and that is the final word on it, LB 235 at this time will be bracketed on final reading until 235A catches up with it, that disposes of the issue of LB 235. Now we can move on perhaps, do we have other motions, we have nothing else on final reading this morning, we have other business before the body, however, the Clerk will take that up at this time.
