CLERK: 25 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is adopted. Back to you, Senator Cavanaugh, on 86.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 86 as amended be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to advance LB 86 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 364.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to adopt the amendments to LB 364. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 364 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of that motion say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB145 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to advance LB 145. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 148 to E & R for engrossment.

CLERK: Mr. President, just a minute.

PRESIDENT: Stand by. Is that on 145?

CLERK: There appear to be...no 148.

PRESIDENT: 148 coming up. OK.

CLERK: There appear to be no E & R amendments, Mr. President, but there are other amendments offered by Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Warner in the chamber? Working on LB 148, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: My motion, Mr. President, is to have the amendment printed in the Journal and then take it up tomorrow. It's a relative short one. I don't think it is controversial but so everyone can understand it why and visiting with Senator Stull, he indicated he thought that it would be preferable to hold it over one day and have the amendment printed in the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections? Any objections to Senator Warner's delay of 148 in order to have the amendment printed in the Journal. Hearing none. So ordered. We will bypass 148, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 254.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to adopt the amendments to 254. All those in favor of that motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: All right. Now, Mr. President, I move to amend LB 254--read.
