CLERK: All right, then, Mr. President there is a pending amendment to LB 193 by Senator Cavanaugh.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Cavanaugh, speaking about your amendments to LB 193.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, members of the body, basically what the amendment does, this would remove the formula for determining the maximum that was formerly in 193 in which the maximum benefit payable to a totally disabled individual would have been determined on the basis of the average weekly wage in the State of Nebraska. It removes that formula from the bill and states in its place a dollar maximum of \$30 per month which would be the maximum benefit available to a totally disabled individual in any one given month. That's the basis of the amendment. I think this amendment satisfies Senator Clark and Senator Kelly and I would hope that it would satisfy most of the other Senators in this body. I think that that was the primary objection to LB 193 and it would be my feeling that that objection is now eliminated.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Cavanaugh amendment? Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: I'd like to amend that to \$89.
