SPEAKER: Yes, I believe you do.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I so move.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter has asked to reconsider the vote. Are you ready for the question? What this simmers down to, is whether we are going to adopt the severability clause or not, all those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 11 nays, on the motion to reconsider.

SPEAKER: Well that is the motion to reconsider which is in effect is a vote, but I suppose now we should vote as to whether we are going to adopt this severability clause. That was a motion actually to reconsider, do you agree with that Mr. Clerk? Alright, now we are ready to vote, on whether to adopt the severability clause. Any discussion? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 13 nays on the motion to adopt.

SPEAKER: The severability clause is adopted, are there further amendments?

CLERK: Yes Mr. President. Not an amendment, a motion, I move to indefinitely postpone LB 268, signed Senator Chambers.

SPEAKER: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would call for the question and this is the test of the strength of the bill.

SPEAKER: Senator Chambers, are you ready for the vote, alright, the question is shall LB 268 be indefinitely postponed, if you are in favor of indefinite postponement you will vote aye, if you are opposed to indefinite postponement you will vote no. This again requires 25 votes. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 26 nays, 12 not voting.

SPEAKER: The motion fails, any further amendments on the Clerk's desk?

CLERK: None.

SPEAKER: Are you ready for the question? The question now is to advance the bill, are there amendments on it now?

CLERK: None further.

SPEAKER: We have adopted some amendments though.

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: The question is to advance the bill as amended. All in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 8 nays, on motion to advance.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. We have a reverting back now to general file, there is a request to pass LB 257, any objections to passing it over? If not we will take up LB 114. The Clerk will read.
