SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the intent of this bill is to provide for the transfer of certain employee accounts from the county systems to the state employees retirement system. This would affect only those employees who were brought under state employment by LB 1032, the Judicial Reform Law enacted by the 1972 session of the Legislature. We believe it is fair and equitable to allow these persons to continue to be a member of a retirement program rather than force them to wait until they have been state employees for two years and then to begin anew in a state system. The fiscal impact will be minor due to the small number of persons. I move for the introduction of this bill.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the bill? The question is shall the bill be introduced. All those in favor will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no.
