

they want that operated, has been made. I think that's the strength of the bill and I would hope the bill would be advanced.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion? If not, Senator Anderson, do you care to close?

SENATOR ANDERSON: I think that Senator Warner--Warner, has done a very excellent job of summing up the arguments for this bill and so I'll let that stand as my closing.

SPEAKER: All those in favor of advancing the bill as amendment--amended, vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 2 nays, 19 not voting.

SPEAKER: Bill is advanced. LB 408.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 408. Introduced by Senator Savage of the 10th district. (read) There are no committee amendments.

SPEAKER: Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. Speaker. The purpose of drafting LB 408 was to clarify the provisions of Section 79-803.5 to provide a method of electing a treasurer of a class 3 school district that lies partly within, in, inside the corporate limits of a city or a village and for them to continue to elect their treasurer like they have been in the past, it, and there was nobody appeared against it; had a public hearing. It came out of the committee 7-0 with one absent and I move this be advanced to E&R initial.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? If there is no discussion, are you ready for the question? Question is shall the bill be advanced? All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, no nays, 21 not voting.

SPEAKER: Bill is advanced. We passed over LB 511 but Senator Kennedy is now here. Clerk will read 511.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 511 (read). There are committee amendments by Senator Kennedy's Public Health Committee.

SPEAKER: Senator Kennedy, do you want to explain the amendments?

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes. Mr. Chairman and fellow Members. The committee amendment is very minor and only changes one word. On page 4, line 4 of the bill, to supervise rather than administrator and this is a term that is used within the Federal rules and regulations and does correspond with that and the bill, I might ask, or state at this time that the bill again is, is something that has bothered particularly some of us that have been working with welfare problems but in the interim study through the last summer, we found out that in the western part of Nebraska we couldn't split the services and administrative without a problem with the Federal Government so this bill will clear up that and give two or more counties to have a supervisor do this service economically and we won't be hurt on our Federal funds so the bill is very minor. The amendment does only change that word to correspond with the Federal. I would ask that the committee amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER: Any discussion on the committee amendments, or are you ready for the question? All those in favor of the committee amendments say aye. Those opposed no. Committee amendments are adopted. Now, Senator what will you do with the bill?
