with Senator Marsh at this time that if this makes the bill unconstitutional, that in no way do we want to hinder the child abuse act so therefore I would support Senator Marsh in having the Barnett amendment withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the amendment? Question is shall the Barnett amendment be withdrawn on LB, stricken on LB 207? All those in favor of striking-- Senator Marvel?

SENATOR MARVEL: I'm not going to, I haven't seen the Attorney General's opinion. I'm not going to fight it but I am going to protest it and I want on record the fact that I think the Attorney General in this case is wrong. Now I say this without having seen all the reasoning and I think I heard the Clerk say that there are no cases that they back this up, well therefore, they're using their personal opinion. I object to this but I won't stop the advancement of the bill. I want to be recorded as protesting this kind of Attorney General's opinion.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion now of the amendment? Or the issue? Question is then, Senator Marsh's motion is to strike the Barnett amendment to LB 207. All those in favor of striking the amendment will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no. Motion is to strike the Barnett amendment to LB 207. Question is shall the amendment be stricken? Question is shall the amendment be stricken? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Well, Senator Marsh?

SENATOR MARSH: I request a call of the house. There has to be 25 votes of this whole thing. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 10 nays, 12 not voting on the motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: The Barnett amendment is stricken then to 207. Do we have other amendments to 207? Very good. Back to you, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 207 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to advance LB 207 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered. The bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 413.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to LB 413. All those in favor of the motion say aye. Those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 413 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance the bill. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 415.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to 415. All those in favor of that motion say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the amendments are adopted.
