SENATOR NORE: Mr. President and fellow members, I still think that your giving the lawyers their own set of statutes to, in this particular area, which I don't think is --

PRESIDENT: Now is there any further discussion of LB 517, excuse me, any further discussion of 517. Senator Luedtke back to you.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Go ahead.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the question is shall LB 517 be advanced from general file to E&R initial, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement now of LB 517 as amended from general file to E&R initial. Have you all voted? The motion is to advance LB 517 from general file to E&R initial, as amended. Thank you, the Clerk will record.
