I'll be willing to ask that the amendment be taken out if there is a dispute between the Investment Board and the State Auditor.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Yes, at the moment I can't see any reason why it wouldn't be all right...

SENATOR MAHONEY: Fine, but if you find one then, in your talking or chatting with them I'll be willing to ask the amendment be withdrawn.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Yes, okay.

PRESIDENT: All right. Question is, shall the Mahoney amendment to LB 396 be adopted? All those in favor please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendment is adopted. Now then according to Senator Carpenter's request, he's asking unanimous consent to bracket the bill with 499, 396 now as amended with 499. Are there objections to bracketing the bill that way? Thank you. Hearing none, so ordered. The bill is bracketed. That moves us on to General File consideration of LB 17A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 17A is Senator Burbach's bill.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. 349.

CLERK: 349 is Senator Waldron's bill, we're trying to locate.

PRESIDENT: Chair doesn't object to that. Senator Duis, you want to handle 17A? Let's read the title here first.

CLERK: Reads title.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, with your indulgence I would take this for him because it's merely the A-bill to support the weights and measures bill that was passed, number 17, which would put the weights and measure fees down on the people who were having these inspected and would give back to the General Fund the expenditure which is in this 17A bill and I would move for its advancement to E & R for Initial.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the bill? Question is, shall LB 17A then be advanced from General File to E & R Initial? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays, Mr. President, on motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: Very good, the bill is advanced. We move to the consideration of LB 349.

CLERK: Reads title. There are Committee amendments by Senator Fred Carstens' Banking Committee.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Duis.
