I move that this be brought back to select file for a specific Amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion. Question is shall 492 be returned to select file for specific Amendment as outlined by Senator Whitney. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Thank-you, clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays. A motion to be returned.

PRESIDENT: Bill is returned. Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Now I move that the Amendment be adopted. I just explained the Amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Amendment. Question is shall the Amendment be adopted. All those in favor, vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Voting on the adoption of the Whitney Amendment to LB 492 on select file. That still requires 25 votes. Clerk will record.

CLERK: Inaudible.

PRESIDENT: Very good. The amendment is adopted. Senator Whitney, back to you.

SENATOR WHITNEY: I move that LB 492 as amended be advanced to E & R engrossing.
