

SPEAKER: Bill is advanced. LB 497.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 497. Introduced by Senator Schmit. (read). There are no committee amendments.

SPEAKER: Senator Schmit. Is this non controversial?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, Mr. Chairman, this is non controversial bill. The processors have been handling this--these products this way for a number of years but at the present, we did not have the authority to supervise the transportation and this merely provides legal authority for the producers to do what they're doing now and keeps them within the law and it is a definite improvement in the transportation of these products and I move the bill be advanced to E&R.

SPEAKER: Is there any discussion? Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye. Those opposed vote no. This requires 20--this requires 25 votes. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, no nays, 23 not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. LB 372.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 372. Introduced by Senator Fowler of the 27th district. (read). There are no committee amendments or other amendments.

SPEAKER: Senator Fowler. The Chair, the Chair should observe, because I have been asked. Certainly there is nothing wrong with the discussion or asking questions and I'm not referring to Senator Fowler's bill, any bill, they're on a non controversial list basically because there was no opposition at the hearing and I think the vote was unanimous. That does not mean they are in fact non controversial but at first blush this is as much as we can determine so it doesn't mean there shouldn't be a discussion, but if it gets into an argument then I'll declare them controversial.
