the expense of state inspection when the inspection they go through is more stringent than the state inspection. Now, what the Committee amendment does, it also excludes some state inspection of the school buses that are again inspected under a more rigid inspection. So, it does eliminate the school buses in the Committee amendment. So, I move for the adoption of the Committee amendment at this time.

SPEAKER: Is there any discussion of the Committee amendment? If not, are you ready for the question. All those in favor of the Committee amendment say aye. Those opposed no. The Committee amendment is adopted. Are there further amendments? Mr. Clerk, is there..are there any...
