PRESIDENT: 86, 193?

CLERK: Otherwise the worksheet is followed from yesterday.

PRESIDENT: And did you say 259?

CLERK: 86, 258, 179.

PRESIDENT: 258 and 179.

CLERK: And 193 are crossed off on this list.

PRESIDENT: Well, apparently we may have to reconsider that. Senator Syas, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SYAS: I just went back to the fiscal staff and they told me they were wrong that 193 had no fiscal impact.

PRESIDENT: Thank you sir.

CLERK: Mr. President, 258 has fiscal impact but was expressly excluded so it would be on the list.

PRESIDENT: Once again the chair would like to ask the Senators please to get in their seats. We're ready for Final Reading now. First bill on Final Reading is LB 68. Clerk will read the bill.

CLERK: Reads bill.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I'd like to at this time ask the indulgence of the Legislature to move from, to move LB 196A back from Final Reading to Select File for a specific amendment. I so move.

PRESIDENT: Wait a minute, what number?

SENATOR SCHMIT: 496A.

PRESIDENT: 496A? The next bill that we have up for consideration is 406, Senator. Your motion would be out of... Oh, thank you, state your motion again, Senator.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, I would move that we return LB 496A from Final Reading to Select File for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question actually before us is, Senator Schmit needs unanimous consent to take up 496 at this particular time. Are there objections to taking up 496 on Final Reading at this time to consider a possible return to Select File for a specific amendment? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. We'll take up 496. All right, Senator, go ahead and explain your predicament here.

SENATOR SCHMIT: 496A is the bill which appropriates from cash funds the money for the grain alcohol program which is included in 496. I have a specific amendment which will provide also to reappropriate these funds for the Legislative Council and the Legislative Fiscal staff and will reappropriate the \$15,000 to the gas alcohol fund which we need to have in the bill to pay those employees for this year and so at this time I'd like to have that moved back so that it could be handled and Emory Burnett could get the necessary paper work done and the bill could then be readvanced to Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to return LB 496 to Select File for a specific amendment. The question is, shall the bill be returned? All those in favor of returning the bill please vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Motion is to return 496 to Select File. Thank you. Clerk will record.
