CLERK: Now Mr. President, I move to unbracket LB 452 on E & R Final and return it to Select File for specific amendment. Signed, Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Marvel. Just a minute Senator Marvel. Senator Proud, I'm sorry, did I by-pass you back there? I honestly didn't see you and your light was on.

SENATOR PROUD: I know you didn't do that intentionally. We got the bill over to E & R for engrossment at the moment, is that right?

PRESIDENT: That's correct and if you were to put another amendment on it, you'd have to...

SENATOR PROUD: Well, I would just ask that--we've got some problems in 66 with this bill and I don't want to get in Senator Nore's way but we want to make sure that it's all right or it isn't all right and I would just ask unanimous consent that it be bracketed

on E & R for a short while until we can, just have, I'd ask unanimous consent it be bracketed and then we'll try to see what our position is on it. But if it comes out on Final Reading and we have to mess around with it again I think that's kind of a waste of money.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nore apparently agrees. Senator Stahmer, do you agree or are there any objections?

SENATOR STAHMER: No, I agree.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Are there any objections then to holding 435 on E & R for engrossing until we give it another look? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered then the bill be held there. We'll move on to 452.

SENATOR MARVEL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm asking that 452 be returned to Select File for a specific amendment that accomplishes two things. One, it simply amends the present Department of Administrative Service statutes and secondly, it makes the inception date flexible so that if the bill does not pass with the emergency clause, it would take effect 90 days after the Legislature were in session. Do I...

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel, why don't you ask unanimous consent to unbracket the bill first?

SENATOR MARVEL: Well, I so--I ask unanimous consent that 452 be unbracketed.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to unbracketing the bill? Hearing none, so ordered. The bill is unbracketed.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move the bill be advanced to Select File for this specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to bring 452 back to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Thank you. Clerk will record. This--no, it's been unbracketed, it's now returned.

CLERK: 25 ayes to return the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Now we're ready for your specific amendment.
