SPEAKER: Clerk will record.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 30 nays, 7 not voting.

SPEAKER: Motion fails. We'll now go to select file. Wait a minute, consideration of bills on select file. Senator Cavanaugh.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill up was 445, I think was, which was once considered on April 18th and then laid over with no further action on the E&R amendments.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 445.

SPEAKER: Those in favor of the E&R amendments to LB 445 say aye. Opposed no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 445 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

SPEAKER: You've heard the motion to advance. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill is advanced.
