

CLERK: 32 ayes, no nays--33 ayes, no nays, remainder not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The bill is referred back to committee. Now we'll proceed with LB 345, on select file.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I'd yield to Senator Kelly, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker and Members of the body, I request unanimous consent to hold LB 345 for one day.

SPEAKER: Are there any objections? If not, so ordered. Proceed with LB 321.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I--I don't know exactly what--Emory Burnett has requested that the E&R amendments to LB 321 not be adopted. I don't--I suppose I could move for the non adoption, is that correct?

CLERK: Just move for the rejection.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Move for the rejection of the amendments to LB 321.

SPEAKER: It's been moved that the E&R amendments to LB 321 be rejected. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed no. The amendments are rejected.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 321 be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

SPEAKER: You've heard the motion. Those in favor of advancing LB 321 say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill advances.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 510.

SPEAKER: You've heard the motion. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed say no. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Alright now, Mr. President, we have some further amendments on LB 510 offered by Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: --(mike off) --distributed on each member's desk a copy of the amendments to 510 which now becomes the bill. Now the reason for that wa--is as I explained earlier that there is some question about the germaneness in the area of the reappropriation of unexpended capital funds by this method to this bill. This bill now is back in its original form which all it does is in the area of the reappropriation, the appropriation of the interest on the bonds for the field house and the additional amendments, additional improvements explained the other day. Now, the reappropriation as I understand it and I hope that Senator Marvel will concur in this if, if I'm right, are going to take place if--we've already referred Senator Fellman's bill which has to do in some degree with the re--reappropriation of capital unexpended funds. It has been sent to the Budget Committee. They, I presume with this bill, will consider the amendments that Senator Fellman has which were in 510 but which in this amendment they have been deleted from 510 so I presume the Budget Committee will either report out one or two bills which will have the capital expenditures as recommended by the Governor or by the Governor and concurred in by the Committee, with or without amendments and on the same bill if they so desire or by a separate bill, they can reappropriate the unexpended funds in the area of capital expenditures,
