

SPEAKER: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Roll call vote read. 45 ayes, no nays, 4 not voting.

SPEAKER: Bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Clerk will read LB 496.

CLERK: Engross Legislative Bill 496. (read)

SPEAKER: Excuse me, Mr. Clerk, all Senators please remain in your seats, what's fair for one is fair for the other. Thank you, Senator Mahoney. Clerk will continue reading.

CLERK: Continues reading.

CLERK: Roll call vote read.

SENATOR CARSTENS: 110 has a fiscal impact of \$13,000 plus a few. I want to call your attention--there has been considerable agitation in the last several years and much public dissatisfaction with the makeup of our constitution--of our constitutionally provided judicial nominating commission which is the vehicle and the instrument by which our vacancies in our district and Supreme Court Judges are filled. Now 110 is the result of a constitutional amendment which was adopted by a large vote in the last election by the people of this State
