

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion, I move to override the Governor's veto on LB 179. Signed Senator Carpenter.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, this has been discussed and I'm sure anything I might say would not change any vote of anybody in this body so I just move the previous question.

SPEAKER: Previous question has been called for. Do I see 5 hands? Alright, all those in favor of debate ceasing vote aye. Those opposed vote no. (mike off)-- to Senator Carpenter's motion to override the Governor's veto on LB 179. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay on motion to cease debate.

SPEAKER: The debate is now ended. Senator Carpenter, do you care to close?

SENATOR CARPENTER: I have nothing to say.

SPEAKER: Question is, shall the Governor's veto be overridden? This requires 30 votes. All those in favor--this is on LB 179. Well technically, the question is shall the bill become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor? In short, if you want to override, you vote green, if you do not want to override, you vote red. All those in favor of overriding the Governor's veto, vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Have you all voted?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Ask for--I ask for the call of the house, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: I see 5 hands. Clerk will clear the board. All those in favor of the call of the house, vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Clerk will record and the house is under call. Will you all please remain in your seats. The Sergeant at Arms please bring in the missing Senators. Record your pre--record your presence. Please record your presence. House is under call. Who's missing, Mr. Clerk? Senator Whitney and Senator Fred Carstens are missing. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, on an issue as crucial as this and I do consider it to be that, I think we ought to show our mettle so I'm going to ask for a roll call vote.

SPEAKER: Roll call vote's been requested. Delay just a moment, Senator Chambers to see if we can get these other two in here. Mr. Clerk, is somebody after the other two--the two Senators that are missing?

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: Clerk will call the roll. House is still under call.

CLERK: Roll call vote read.

SPEAKER: House is still under call. Senator Carstens, the question is, shall the Governor's veto of LB 179 be overridden? Roll call vote.

CLERK: Senator Whitney, did you wish to vote on the motion? Senator Whitney not voting. Senator Barnett not voting.
