SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter, this bill was put back here for a specific amendment, so we are going to follow the Rules. We've got to suspend the Rules and adopt the amendment. So, you are asking to suspend the Rules.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yes, I so move.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? Are you ready for the question? The question is shall the emergency clause be adopted. Suspension of the Rules requires 30 votes. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes on the motion to suspend the Rules and adopt the amendment.

SPEAKER: The emergency clause is added. Are there any further amendments to the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Now, we have adopted the Committee amendments, right?

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: Now, Senator Cavanaugh, what will you do with the bill?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 494 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: Is there any discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill as amended say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 266.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? All those in favor of the adoption of the amendments, say aye. Those opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 266 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? If not, all those in favor of advancing the bill say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 55.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? All those in favor of the adoption of the amendments say aye. Those opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: All right. I've got a whole series of amendments.

SPEAKER: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a series of amendments on the bill. The first amendment is offered by Senator Mahoney. Read. Signed, Senator Whitney. I mean signed, Senator Mahoney.

SPEAKER: Mr. Clerk, is this LB 55?

CLERK: Ya.
