CLERK: Yes, Mr. President. I ask unanimous consent to place LB 573 to fifth place on general file.

SPEAKER: Who, who made this motion?

CLERK: Signed Senator Whitney.

SPEAKER: Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, this bill is designed to correct the situation created by the corporate form bill and which a group of court employees were changed from county employees to State employees and unless we have this bill passed, these people are going to lose all their retirement interest that they have had in the past and so I want this if possible to consider that fifth on general file. I ask unanimous consent.

SPEAKER: Any objection to that? Any objection to Senator Whitneys motion? If not, so ordered. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: One more motion Mr. President. I move that we reconsider our action on the Stahmer motion found on page 1297, of the Legislative Journal, to be amended to read as follows after 259 to add, and all tort claims bills, signed Senator Richendifer.

SPEAKER: Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. Speaker members of the Legislature. This is a follow up on the payment of 542. To make sure that this can be done, I want it included in Senator Stahmers motion of, on page 1297 of the Journal.

SPEAKER: Senator Richendifer, I don't know that you can amend a motion. Do you agree with that Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Well yes, I rewrote his motion to read a reconsideration of that motion so as to include.

SPEAKER: Well if the effect is to reconsider it, Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: All this is, is merely it is no different from adding all the Governors bills in on the, on Senator Stahmers motion. It is merely to take care of the tort claims. These are bills that are owed by the State of Nebraska, to the newspaper media and to include this to make sure that this can be done and I would ask for unanimous consent to reconsider the motion and add this to Senator Stahmers motion.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter, Then Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well this is the same. We're trying to break the jame on A bill. Now why don't we make a determination. Now either to stay like we are, or lets consider A bills. Let's do it by direct action. Is his motion amendable?

SPEAKER: May the chair suggest Senator Richendifer. We have we've spent 45 minutes or so this morning on these A bills. Would you be willing to delay your motion till tomorrow till the appropriations committee has considered all this matter?

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Fine.

SPEAKER: I'm not trying to direct you in any way. You can do what ever you can do.
